The JE Murray Home now have confirmed cases of COVID-19, from Monday 23/5/22 and is now reporting directly to the WA Department of Health.

Those residents affected are doing well and their families or representatives are aware of this situation.

Visiting the JE Murray Home is still permitted to those that are fully vaccinated and have a 2022 Influenza vaccination but if visiting an area within the facility that is classed as a RED Zone, full Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) must be worn.

Those residents that are COVID-19 positive are permitted one (1) Essential Visitor per day for a maximum of 1 hour.
