Number of Active Cases

There are currently 6 active resident cases

Actions

- Positive residents have been isolated to their rooms, are being supported and staff attending are wearing full PPE
- Site wide PCR testing is being undertaken – we will only contact residents and families in the event of a positive result
- Staff across the site are wearing masks

Visiting

- Visiting restricted to essential visitors only at this time
- All visitors are required to provide evidence of a negative Rapid Antigen Test on entry to the facility.
- Masks are to be worn at all times
- Full PPE will be required if attending a COVID positive resident in their room
